NETBALL PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT



As a player, you must meet the following requirements in regards to your conduct during any activity held or sanctioned by SASN.

- Play by the rules:
 - Know the rules
- Participate fairly and safely.
- Abide by decisions, without argument or bad temper.
 - Captains have the right to approach an umpire during an interval or after the game for clarification of any rule.
 - Captains must approach the umpire in a courteous and polite way.
 - Actions speak louder than words. Ensure that both on and off the court your behaviour is consistent with the principles of good sportsmanship.
- Co-operate with your coach and other players at all times.
 - Verbal abuse of officials or other players is not acceptable or permitted.
 - Treat all players as you would like to be treated.
 - Ensure that at all times your behaviour is fair.
 - Be a patient and enthusiastic supporter of fellow players.
- Be a responsible team member.
 - Always be on time.
 - Encourage and assist all players.
 - Attend all training sessions.
 - Ensure you always bring the appropriate uniform and equipment to training and/or matches.
- Any practices that affect sporting performance (alcohol, tobacco and drug use) is strictly prohibited.
- Respect and acknowledge the contribution of those who create the opportunity for you to play.
 - Volunteers (scorers, coaches, timekeepers, administrators and umpires)
- Refrain from any behaviour that may bring SASN into disrepute.
- Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
- Report any grievances promptly to the coach or team manager, who will deal with this confidential, using appropriate procedures.
- Understand the repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches of this Code of Conduct.

UMPIRES' CODE OF CONDUCT

PARENTS' AND SPECTATORS CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1.1.1 Remember that children play sport primarily for their enjoyment and not yours.
- 1.1.2 Encourage children to participate and do not force them to do so.
- 1.1.3 Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than the winning or losing.
- 1.1.4 Encourage children to participate according to the rules of the game. Teach your child that honest endeavour is as important as winning and do all you can to encourage good sportsmanship.
- 1.1.5 Use Social Media technology to bring the game into disrepute or make an inappropriate comment about a player, coach, official, volunteer or member of the EXCO of SASN.
- 1.1.6 Arrive at a netball activity under the influence of or consume illegal substances, alcoholic drinks, smoke or vape either immediately before or while being at a netball activity where my child is participating in the Sport.
- 1.1.7 Never ridicule, belittle, threaten or yell or use abusive behaviour or foul language at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- 1.1.8 Never engage in discriminatory abuse or anti-social behaviour which could include but is not limited to racism, sexism, hate speech, homophobic or transphobic behaviour
- 1.1.9 Remember children learn best by example. Encourage and support but applaud good play by all players.
- 1.1.10 Respect your child's teammates, parents and teammates and parents from opposite teams.
- 1.1.11 Never intentionally or unintentionally expose any young participant to embarrassment or disparagement by using flippant and/or sarcastic remarks.
- 1.1.12 Respect officials' and umpires' decisions and rulings and teach children to do likewise. Never interfere with the game or the officials/umpires/coaches.
- 1.1.13 Always show appreciation to volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
- 1.1.14 Read the rules of the Sport to understand better what I am watching and discussing with my child.
- 1.1.15 Promote this code of conduct to other parents, carers and supporters.

1.1.16 Be aware of my SASN's child safeguarding policy and ensure that any concerns are reported to the team safeguarding officer or SASN Safeguarding Officer whose details are available on SASN's website.

1.1.17 Parents should support all efforts to remove abusive behaviour and bullying in all its forms and uphold children's safeguarding.
